

Sunnica Webinar – Construction and Operations Webinar (17/10/2020), answers to unanswered questions

During the webinar it was not possible to answer all of the questions asked. Answers to any unanswered questions are given in this document.

Does Sunnica have a Modern Slavery Policy that meets the requirements of the Modern Slavery Act 2018? Where can this be viewed and how are Sunnica applying this policy in the procurement of components from China?

Sunnica Ltd. does not currently have an annual turnover of £36 million or more and is therefore not legally required to publish a modern slavery statement under the Modern Slavery Act 2015. We recognise that there are risks of modern slavery being connected to UK businesses and supply chains. We will seek to address these risks through our supply chain and during the procurement process to uphold the high ethical standards that we expect.

I'm sure as part of this statutory consultation you are keeping statistics on interactions with the general public. Please advise how many calls have been received to the helpline number so far.

We will publish details of our consultation activity within a Consultation Report that will be available to view as part of our Development Consent Order (DCO) application.
